

Town Hall Farmer's Market of Greensboro

Rules

1. The market will be held on Mondays from 3 to 6 p.m. on the green in front of the Town Hall. Monday, May 31, 2010 will be the opening day.
2. Items sold at the market must be grown or made in Vermont. Items may not be brought in for resale.
3. Vendors must be in compliance with state regulations. If you need any forms or permits you must have them and submit a copy with your application.
4. Vendors are encouraged to carry their own liability insurance.
5. All fees are due with application. Contact Town Clerk if you need to pay in installments.
6. All goods and apparatus must be removed by one hour after the close of the market.
7. All garbage of any kind must be removed by one hour after the close of the market.
8. Parking will be available in front of and in back of the town hall. No parking will be permitted on the east side of Lauredon Avenue or either side of Craftsbury Road. Vendors with equipment that needs to be parked on the green will be allowed to park on the east lawn.
9. No alcohol or tobacco is permitted on town hall property. (Vendors selling alcoholic beverages with proper state licenses excepted.)
